## Expocobre 2024 will be held from October 28 to 31 next year, it has been confirmed.

The first edition of Expocobre 2023 brought together experts and industry leaders to address the challenges and demands of the red metal.

EXPOCOBRE 2024 will be held from October 28 to 31 next year, providing a new opportunity for the copper mining industry to meet and discuss the challenges and advances in the sector. This was confirmed by Alfredo Olaya, general manager of InterMet Peru, during the closing ceremony of the first edition of the event.

During his speech, he expressed his satisfaction for having taken the initiative to organize a world conference on red metal in Peru. "It is impressive that, being the world's second largest copper producer, Peru has not had a conference of this magnitude. "We expect an even greater participation in EXPOCOBRE 2024, learning from this first edition and improving in all aspects. The comments towards the organization have been very positive and we hope that all the players in the mining industry will join the next edition," added Olaya.

Regarding the theme of the event, he stressed the urgency of the demand for copper and the importance of focusing on this metal. "The demand for copper is pressing and there is a gap in supply. Therefore, we will continue to address the related topics in this first edition and analyze the progress until October 2024," he stressed.

Expocobre 2024 will become the most modern fair as it will include the dynamic exhibition of machinery and equipment, together with the use of automation and artificial intelligence in all its processes and activities, which will make it a revolutionary format in Peru and Latin America.
