## Minera Las Bambas expects to become a fully digital mine by 2030.

Edgardo Orderique, general manager of the mining company, also emphasized the company's commitment to emissions reduction and digital transformation during Expocobre 2023.

During his participation at EXPOCOBRE 2023, Edgardo Orderique, general manager of Orderique announced that the mining company expects to become a 100% smart mine by 2030. "We are currently at approximately 40%," he said.

"When you go to Las Bambas, the exploration processes, machinery or plants, has to be highly digital," he added during his talk where he addressed the challenges and opportunities facing the of the challenges and opportunities facing the mining company today. He also highlighted the importance of technology and the integration of the management team to achieve success in the implementation of initiatives.

Orderique also revealed that they expect to reduce emissions by 40% by 2030, and to achieve zero emissions thereafter. "The first issue to address is the energy matrix, ensuring that it comes from renewable sources. In this regard, we already ENEL certification, which guarantees that all energy production comes from renewable sources. We must ensure that this energy comes from that source", he said.

"The technological issues that are very exciting and friendly to everyone do not necessarily flow or are implemented in such a friendly way. It requires retention and an integration of the entire management team to make it happen successfully." Orderique stated during his presentation.

These statements reflect the commitment of Minera Las Bambas to face the challenges and take advantage of the opportunities offered by technology in the mining industry. The company continues to work to improve efficiency and reduce its environmental impact through the implementation of advanced technological solutions.
